**Subject:** A condition from conditional surety agreement met.

**Legal basis:** §5 section 1 item 4 of the Ordinance of the Minister of Finance of 19 February 2009 on current and interim information submitted by issuers of securities, and on conditions of considering as equivalent the information required by law of a non-member state.

**Report content:**

Pursuant to the report no 19/2016 of 23.05.2016, the Management Board of OPTeam SA (the Issuer), announces, that in relation to concluding with Polska Wytwórnia Papierów Wartościowych SA with its seat in Warsaw at ul. R. Sanguszki 1 (Polish Security Printing Works, hereinafter: PSPW) the agreement on sale of shares of Centrum Rozliczeń Elektronicznych Polskie ePłatności SA with its seat in Rzeszów (Centre of Electronic Clearance Polish ePayment, hereinafter: Polish ePayment) held by PWPW, to the benefit of OPTeam SA, on which the Issuer informed in the current report no 24/2016 on 22.06.2016, the condition precedent of the conditional surety agreement concluded with with Kolporter spółka z ograniczoną odpowiedzialnością sp. k. [limited liability company limited partnership] with its seat in Kielce at ul. Zagnańska 61, 25-528 Kielce, entered into the Register of Entrepreneurs of the National Court Register kept by the District Court in Kielce under KRS number 0000525374, NIP 9591452482, REGON 291770790, represented by the general partner – Kolporter Spółka z ograniczoną odpowiedzialnością [limited liability company] with its seat in Kielce; address ul.Zagnańska 61, 25-528 Kielce, entered into the Register of Entrepreneurs kept by District Court in Kielce, 10th Commercial Division of the National Court Register at number 0000377893, REGON 121454196 (hereinafter: Kolporter) has been met, on which the Issuer informed in aforementioned current report no19/2016 of 23.05.2016.

Following the conclusion of the agreement on acquisition of Polish ePayment shares from PWPW, the Issuer submitted a relevant statement addressed to Kolporter company and as a result Polish Security Printing Works was exempted from the debt and the surety agreement dated on 14 May 2013 concluded between Polish Security Printing Works, Kolporter and Centre of Electronic Clearance Polish ePayment was terminated.
